**BOARD OF HEALTH
Study Session
January 29, 2020**

On January 29, 2020 the Board of Health of the Champaign-Urbana Public Health District (CUPHD) held a Study Session at 201 W. Kenyon Rd., Champaign, Illinois. Mr. Andy Quarnstrom called the meeting to order at 10:32 AM. Upon roll call, the following board members were found to be present: Mr. Andy Quarnstrom, Chair, Ms. Danielle Chynoweth, Secretary and Mr. Giraldo Rosales.

Mr. Jim Roberts presented current fees for the food inspection program and the food plan review program for board discussion. The Board declined to pursue contacting the Champaign or Urbana City Councils regarding sharing their recently increased Food & Beverage sales tax revenue to help fund the food programs. The board agreed that CUPHD needs to increase fees, but to increase fees over next the several years using the inflation rate forward from 2006. The board also gave direction on reviewing said fees on a 2-year cycle.

Mr. Awais Vaid reported to the Board that the District is having discussions regarding receiving a portion of funding from the recreational cannabis tax revenue from the cities of Champaign and Urbana to address the complex set of emerging risks and challenges related to legalized cannabis. C-UPHD is committed to working with partners to apply a public health approach and social justice lens to this issue. The main priorities are to protect the community from unintended consequences and prevent negative health impacts, particularly among youth and other vulnerable populations.

Mr. Awais Vaid reported that the proposed budget includes the actual cost of programming for both cities, Champaign and Urbana. C-UPHD proposes each city contributes a dollar amount based on their population percentage (Champaign @60% and Urbana @40%) with an inflation increase yearly.

The next monthly meeting will be held on February 10, 2020 at 4:30 PM and the next study session on February 26, 2020 at 10:30 AM.

With no further business to be discussed, Mr. Giraldo Rosales made a motion to adjourn the Study Session at 11:26 AM. Mr. Andy Quarnstrom seconded the motion. With all in favor the motion carried.
