#### **TIMES Center**

Staff from the Division of Infectious Disease Prevention & Management is present at the TIMES Center from 7-7:30 am on Monday mornings to conduct TB Skin Testing and Wednesday mornings form 7-7:30 am to read the skin testing.

During the month of December, 12 clients were TB Skin Tested.

#### Stepping Stones, Salvation Army

# Jail Project: Check Out Healthy

The Illinois Department of Public Health will not be funding "Check Out Healthy" in SFY 2012 as it has for the past several years. CUPHD management has decided to continue this much needed service as many clients have tested positive for Chlamydia through this project. All inmates who meet the IDPH screening criteria will be offered urine-based testing for gonorrhea and Chlamydia. All inmates who meet screening criteria for HIV testing will be offered testing through the HIV testing program. HIV testing is reported above. All inmates will continue to be screened for syphilis.

#### **Juvenile Detention Center Outreach**

Staff from CUPHD provides STD skill-based prevention education at the Champaign County Juvenile Detention Center at least one time each month. Urine screening for Chlamydia & Gonorrhea is offered to all of the youth.

In December, 11 clients were tested for gonorrhea & Chlamydia.

#### **Pregnancy Screening Project**

**9 women** were tested for Gonorrhea and Chlamydia when seeking Pregnancy testing in December. Of those testing, 1 (11%) was positive for Chlamydia and 0 (0%) were positive for gonorrhea.


