## Jail Project: Check Out Healthy

All adult inmates at the Champaign County Correctional Facility who meet the IDPH screening criteria will be offered urine-based testing for gonorrhea and Chlamydia, rapid testing for HIV, and a blood draw for syphilis.

At the Champaign County Juvenile Detention Center urine screening for Chlamydia & Gonorrhea is offered to all of the youth.
