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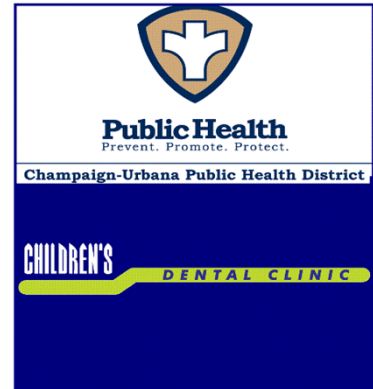
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# CUPHD Dental Program

Champaign-Urbana Public Health District's Champaign Dental Clinic provides a Dental Home for children with All Kids who are residents of Champaign or Urbana. Appointments are available Monday - Friday, 8am - 4pm with Emergency and Urgent Care appointments also available. Parents are encouraged to schedule dental visits after their child's first birthday. The clinic is staffed by a dentist and 2 hygienists, however, beginning February 1st the patient case load required that we increase to 2 dentists on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

A tobacco sales compliance program. We notify all tobacco vendors that we will check for compliance with minimum age laws. After we test the stores, we send congratulatory letters if they pass, as well as notices of failure. This is in cooperation with local law enforcement. Vendors are checked for compliance 3 times per year.

## Events

Talia and Whitney held two REALITY meetings at J.W. Eater Junior High School in Rantoul and served 11 people.

# Illinois Breast & Cervical Cancer Program (IBCCP)

IBCCP contracts with local medical providers to provide free breast and cervical cancer screening for Illinois women ages 35-64 with no health insurance, Medicaid, or Medicare part B. The CUPHD IBCCP serves women from Champaign, McLean and Vermilion Counties. CUPHD IBCCP provides community outreach as well as educational materials and presentations throughout our service area to encourage all women to have their annual screenings done and to seek new client enrollment in order to provide uninsured screenings for women who would otherwise have no access to these services. Approximately 40% of the screening tests yield abnormal results requiring IBCCP medical case management and diagnostics services. While women under the age of 35 are not eligible for screening through this program, they may be eligible for medically indicated diagnostic services if referred by their medical provider. If diagnosed, eligible women are transferred into Medicaid for cancer treatment.

## January 2016

Most of January was spent regrouping and planning future outreach activities for the remainder of FY16. 38.25 hours were spent in meetings and teleconferences with CUPHD staff and community members to ensure we continue to locate our target population and get services to those women in need.

CUPHD held an informational booth in the main lobby for 2 days, providing cervical cancer awareness. 76 women were provided with cervical cancer screening education and IBCCP enrollment information. 80 IBCCP clients throughout our 3 serviced counties were given breast and cervical guideline education.

Due to decreased funding, our IBCCP agency has been placed on a "Priority List" with the state. This restricts the first-served clients to those with abnormalities. Those clients in need of only screening services are placed on a wait list until monies for standard screening services are available. Clients maintain enrollment in our program but may need to wait several months before our program can case manage and pay for their screening services.

\*Champaign-Urbana indicates women residing in the city limits of Champaign and Urbana. Champaign Co. indicates women residing in Champaign County, but outside the city limits of Champaign and Urbana. These columns must be added together for the total number of Champaign County women served.
