

# HOW WILL I KNOW WHEN IT IS MY TURN TO GET THE COVID-19 VACCINE?



Follow our website and social media pages closely to see what phase of COVID-19 vaccine allocation we are in. We anticipate that the COVID-19 vaccine will not be widely available until 2021. Eventually, **everyone who wants a vaccine** will be able to get one.

The first supplies of the vaccine will be limited and given first to specific groups at the **highest risk** such as healthcare workers, people in nursing homes, frontline essential workers, and persons aged 75+. When the vaccine is widely available, healthcare clinics, pharmacies, and drive-through and walk-through clinics will likely provide vaccinations.

Current estimates indicate there will be enough supply to provide COVID-19 vaccines for 20 million people in December, 30 million people in January, and 50 million people in February.

While we wait to get everyone in our community vaccinated, it is important to remember that **wearing a mask, social distancing, and monitoring yourself** for symptoms are still the best ways to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
