Gonorrhea Elimination Project

In the project, CUPHD staff will follow up with all persons who test positive for gonorrhea in the communities of Champaign, Urbana, and Rantoul. Partner services will be offered to each individual and each of their partners will be contacted and offered testing and treatment for gonorrhea.

In September, **18 clients** were contacted for this service.

Communicable Disease*

- Three C-U District residents and one Champaign County resident were diagnosed with chickenpox.
- One District resident and one County resident were diagnosed with E. coli.
- One County resident was diagnosed with Hepatitis A.
- One District resident was diagnosed with Pertussis.
- One District resident and one County resident were diagnosed with Salmonella.

Jail Project: **Check Out Healthy**

The Illinois Department of Public Health will not be funding "Check Out Healthy" in SFY 2012 as it has for the past several years. CUPHD management has decided to continue this much needed service as many clients have tested positive for Chlamydia through this project. All inmates who meet the IDPH screening criteria will be offered urine-based testing for gonorrhea and Chlamydia. All inmates who meet screening criteria for HIV testing will be offered testing

through the HIV testing program. HIV testing is reported above. All inmates will continue to be screened for syphilis.

VOICES: In September, **2 clients** attended the CDC recommended group prevention and support intervention “VOICES”. This is a one time group prevention session that uses a video to teach condom negotiation and use skills.

Juvenile Detention Center Outreach

Staff from CUPHD provides STD skill-based prevention education at the Champaign County Juvenile Detention Center at least one time each month. Urine screening for Chlamydia & Gonorrhea is offered to all of the youth.

In September, **13 clients** were tested for gonorrhea & Chlamydia. 4 clients tested positive this month for Chlamydia and 1 for gonorrhea, (1 result still pending).

Pregnancy Screening Project

6 women were tested for Gonorrhea and Chlamydia when seeking Pregnancy testing in September. Of those testing, 1 (17%) was positive for Chlamydia and 0 (0%) were positive for gonorrhea.

TIMES Center

Staff from the Division of Infectious Disease Prevention & Management is present at the TIMES Center from 7-7:30 am on Monday mornings to conduct TB Skin Testing and Wednesday mornings from 7-7:30 am to read the skin testing.

During the month of September, **19 clients** sought TB Skin Testing.

Stepping Stones, Salvation Army

Staff from the Division of Infectious Disease Prevention & Management is present at the TIMES Center from 7:30-8 am on Monday mornings to conduct TB Skin Testing and Wednesday mornings from 7:30-8am to read the skin testing.

In September, **1 clients** received TB Skin Testing.

Center for Women in Transition

Staff from the Division of Infectious Disease Prevention & offer TB skin testing to residents at CWIT, as needed.

During the month of September, **5** received TB Skin Testing.



This fall, the Division of Infectious Disease has two temporary working with our staff.

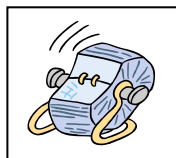
