This project has been completed with IDPH. CUPHD will start to contact persons who test positive for gonorrhea and Chlamydia in one of our STD clinics or outreach testing venues to conducted expanded partner services.

Communicable Disease*

- One District resident was diagnosed with Pertussis.
- Two District residents were diagnosed with Giardiasis.
- One District resident and one County resident were diagnosed with Salmonella.

The CD Coordinator coordinated mitigation efforts for Norovirus outbreaks a local restaurant in the District and a day care facility in the County this month.

The CUPHD TB Control Nurse works with each client who has a reactive TB Skin Test in a CUPHD clinic to ensure follow medical care. If the client does not have a physician, the TB Control Nurse coordinates the follow up with Frances Nelson.

In December, we had a call about a suspect 18 month old with pulmonary TB. 4 drugs were started. Subsequently they were discontinued and the patient is being treated for latent TB. Also, there is a suspect miliary (disseminated) TB case currently hospitalized in St. Louis, who is a resident of Urbana.

Community Based TB Skin Testing (included in totals above)

TIMES Center

Staff from the Division of Infectious Disease Prevention & Management is present at the TIMES Center from 7-7:30 am on Monday mornings to conduct TB Skin Testing and Wednesday mornings form 7-7:30 am to read the skin testing.

During the month of December, **10 clients** were TB Skin Tested.

Stepping Stones, Salvation Army

Staff from the Division of Infectious Disease Prevention & Management is present at the TIMES Center from 7:30-8 am on Monday mornings to conduct TB Skin Testing and Wednesday mornings from 7:30-8am to read the skin testing.

In December, **1 client** received TB Skin Testing.

Center for Women in Transition/ A Women's Fund

Staff from the Division of Infectious Disease Prevention & offer TB skin testing to residents at CWIT/AWF, as needed.

During the month of December, **1** received TB Skin Testing.

Jail Project: *Check Out Healthy*

The Illinois Department of Public Health will not be funding "Check Out Healthy" in SFY 2012 as it has for the past several years. CUPHD management has decided to continue this much needed service as many clients have tested positive for Chlamydia through this project. All inmates who meet the IDPH screening criteria will be offered urine-based testing for gonorrhea and Chlamydia. All inmates who meet screening criteria for HIV testing will be offered testing through the HIV testing program. HIV testing is reported above. All inmates will continue to be screened for syphilis.

Juvenile Detention Center Outreach

Staff from CUPHD provides STD skill-based prevention education at the Champaign County Juvenile Detention Center at least one time each month. Urine screening for Chlamydia & Gonorrhea is offered to all of the youth.

In December, **6 clients** were tested for gonorrhea & Chlamydia. 2 clients tested positive this month for Chlamydia and 0 for gonorrhea.

Pregnancy Screening Project

7 women were tested for Gonorrhea and Chlamydia when seeking Pregnancy testing in December. Of those testing, 0 (0%) was positive for Chlamydia and 0 (0%) were positive for gonorrhea.

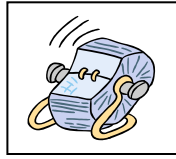
Whitney Hayes is volunteering this semester. She is working on the CUPHD 75th Anniversary Celebration that will be held in 2012.
