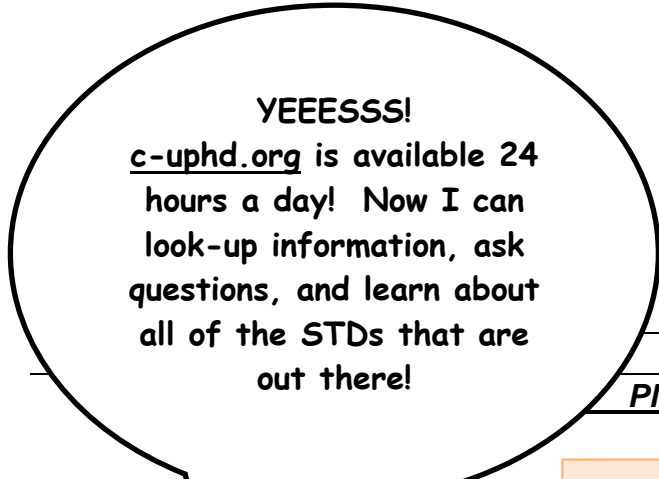

Special Events: CUPHD provided a mobile for Community Health Partnership, a Federally Qualified Health Center that conducts outreach with migrant farm workers in Champaign County. This outreach was conducted three times a week for the month of July. General medical attention is provided. 80 persons received services during this outreach.

In addition, CUPHD provided a mobile and STD screening services during the annual Rantoul Harvest Festival. Two persons received screening and numerous others received risk reduction supplies.

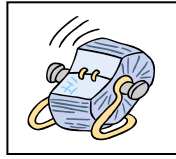
