**SPECIAL EVENTS:** Three testing events were conducted this month for World AIDS Day on Dec 1. CUPHD offered HIV testing at Chester St in Champaign, outside of the Nesbitt Cultural Center at UIUC, and at Eastern Illinois University. Over 50 people were tested at these events.

Clients seeking family planning services can either call for an appointment or walk in for services. Clients in the CUPHD STD and WIC clinics are encouraged to seek family planning services, when needed. All family planning clients are offered STD/HIV testing during their visit. STD testing completed with these clients was reported in the STD section of this report. Pap testing is provided for all women over the age of 21 who attend this clinic and who have not had a pap testing in the past three years.

In December, CUPHD TB Control staff had two LTBI clients on the weekly Rifapentine/Isoniazid DOT regime. In addition, staff continued to work up the potential case for active pulmonary TB at a local shelter. At this time, does not appear to be TB, however, there were questions of potential inadequate treatment of prior TB overseas.

Staff conducted **22 TB Skin Tests\***

The CUPHD TB Control Nurse works with each client who has a reactive TB Skin Test in a CUPHD clinic to ensure follow medical care. If the client does not have a physician, the TB Control Nurse coordinates the follow up with Frances Nelson.

### **Community Based TB Skin Testing (included in totals above)**

#### **TIMES Center**

Staff from the Division of Infectious Disease Prevention & Management is present at the TIMES Center from 7-7:30 am on Monday mornings to conduct TB Skin Testing and Wednesday mornings form 7-7:30 am to read the skin testing. **10 clients** were TB Skin Tested. **0 clients** was tested for HIV and syphilis.

#### **Stepping Stones, Salvation Army**

Staff from the Division of Infectious Disease Prevention & Management is present at the TIMES Center from 7:30-8 am on Monday mornings to conduct TB Skin Testing and Wednesday mornings form 7:30-8am to read the skin testing. **8 clients** received TB Skin Testing and **0 clients** were tested for HIV/Syphilis and **0 client** for Gonorrhea/Chlamydia (0 pos Chlamydia).

#### **Center for Women in Transition/ A Women's Fund**

Staff from the Division of Infectious Disease Prevention & offer TB skin testing to residents at CWIT/AWF, as needed. **0 clients** received TB Skin Testing.

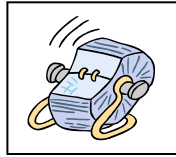
