January: Visited 3 Schools - 202 Exams, 80 Cleanings, 79 Fluorides, 157 Sealants placed.
February: Visited 5 Schools - 193 Exams, 85 Cleanings, 84 Fluorides, 143 Sealants placed.
March: Visited 4 Schools - 124 Exams, 56 Cleanings, 56 Fluorides, 13 Sealants placed.
April: Visited 3 Schools - 148 Exams, 78 Cleanings, 77 Fluorides, 151 Sealants placed.

The School Sealant Program does not see patients during the months of May, June, July and August.

After we test the stores, we send congratulatory letters if they pass, as well as notices of failure. This is in cooperation with local law enforcement. Vendors are checked for compliance 3 times per year.

Puja's Corner



Events

Jennifer Jackson attended the Rantoul Harvest Festival and provided program information offered at C-UPHD.

We hired a student, Puja Paudel, from the Summer Youth Employment Program. Puja worked 4 days per week, about 20 hours per week. She worked in our Wellness and Health Promotion Division. Puja did many things while she was here, but her main focus was the “Kids’ Corner”. The Kids’ Corner is a small, sectioned off waiting area in CUPHD’s lobby where we set up table and chairs for Puja to give educational presentations of various health related topics (see pictures above). During her time, Puja covered the topics of healthy nutrition, proper dental hygiene for kids, and mosquito education. Puja served approximately 139 participants, with the majority (123) of them being pre-school aged. CUPHD is a Summer Food Program site so children ages 18 and under can come to CUPHD to get free breakfast, lunch, and snack. Puja was also able to get certified in basic life support and CPR from the American Heart Association through training at CUPHD. Puja also worked on various small tobacco policy projects with CUPHD’s Special Project Coordinator, Tara McCauley.

Illinois Breast & Cervical Cancer Program (IBCCP)

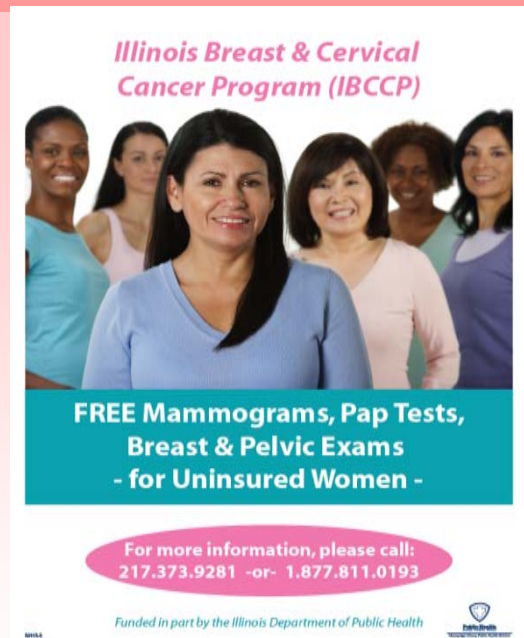
IBCCP contracts with local medical providers to provide free breast and cervical cancer screening for Illinois women ages 35-64 with no health insurance, Medicaid, or Medicare part B. The CUPHD IBCCP serves women from Champaign, McLean and Vermilion Counties. CUPHD IBCCP provides community outreach as well as educational materials and presentations throughout our service area to encourage all women to have their annual screenings done and to seek new client enrollment in order to provide uninsured screenings for women who would otherwise have no access to these services. Approximately 40% of the screening tests yield abnormal results requiring IBCCP medical case management and diagnostics services. While women under the age of 35 are not eligible for screening through this program, they may be eligible for medically indicated diagnostic services if referred by their medical provider. If diagnosed, eligible women are transferred into Medicaid for cancer treatment.

Due to the acquisition of Peoria, Marshall, and Woodford (PMW) counties IBCCP outreach activities were limited so that we could focus on transitioning clients into our caseload for the new fiscal year. Distribution of IBCCP grocery totes was focused on food pantries at CUPHD. PMW provider contracts are pending. IBCCP presented the program highlights to 5 providers in PMW.

The first month of the fiscal year finds IBCCP over caseload by 10 clients. Enrollment continues in an upward trend and re-enrollment remains high. We are discharging fewer than 5 women a month to Medicaid/ACA.
