Housing supportive services programs. Case managers help client to keep safe and affordable housing, get and keep a job, find educational programs, and boost health and well-being.

Provides housing for individuals and families who are HIV-positive and experiencing homelessness.

Provides housing and services to people and families who are victims of domestic violence.

Transitional supportive housing is available. Participation in case management and spiritual mentoring is required.

Provides housing and other resources to men, upon release from IDOC. Arrangements must be made before release from prison. Intense aftercare program that is crisis-based.

Merci's Refuge..... (217) 378 4045

Location: 209 E. Wilbur Avenue, Champaign.

Pregnancy Resource Center Program. Faith-based organization that offers a housing program, at no cost, to women in crisis. This is a 6-9 month residential program that requires an application. This is not an emergency shelter.

Restoration Urban Ministries..... (217) 355 2662

Location: 1213 Parkland Ct., Champaign.

Faith-based organization that provides comprehensive services to individuals, families, and single parents. Includes temporary housing, classes and workshops, case management, employment and spiritual guidance and counseling, substance abuse recovery programs, a food and clothing pantry, and skills training. 11 month intensive program that requires mandatory orientation to be considered.
